Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be developing our social skills, inviting other children to join our play and to play in a group.

We will be supported to wait our turn and to share resources and space with others.

We will talk about keeping safe and being kind to each other.



Physical development

We will use a variety of tools and equipment safely.


We will talk about keeping safe when climbing.

We will make lots of different marks including lines and circles (eg. drawing, painting, finger painting).

We will explore different ways of moving around the environment.



Communication and Language



We will be encouraged to ask and answer a range of questions (eg. What, where, who).

We will be supported to use more complex sentences in our play, using the words 'and' and 'because' (eg. "I'm wearing a hat because it's cold").



Maths

We will recite numbers in order to 10 and begin to represent numbers using fingers, marks on paper or pictures (surveys, tallies).

We will use different construction materials to build models and talk about these with our friends. We will describe our models using words like "big", "round" or "tall".

Understanding of the world



We will mix different ingredients together - making different foods and play dough.

We will explore the outdoor environment and will use the natural resources in our play.

We will use cameras to record our interests and favourite things.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will learns new action songs and tap out simple repeated patterns by clapping and using musical instruments.

We will explore different materials to make models and art work.

We will continue to explore colour mixing.

Literacy

We will talk about the marks we make and draw pictures of our favourite stories.

We will share books with our friends and look at our favourite books independently.

We will make up our own stories using different toys and resources.
