Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be talking about growing up and moving on to Primary School (or returning in September).

We will continue to support turn taking, risk taking and problem solving in the environment.

Physical Development

We will continue to take responsibility for our self care routine - we will use the toilet independently and then wash our hands, we will dress ourselves and we will feed ourselves.

We will practice using pens and pencils to make marks, write our name and other letters.

Communication and Language

We will be listening to stories with and without pictures or props, and will share stories we have made up ourselves.

We will continue to listen and respond to ideas expressed by others in conversation and discussion.

Maths

We will continue to use language to compare different sizes.

We will continue to sing songs and say numbers to 20.

We will be playing with and learning the names of 2D and 3D shapes.

Understanding of the World

We will explore the garden and continue to watch and talk about our growing plants.

We will talk about our learning and reflect on our time at Triangle by looking at our special books.

We will look closely at life cycles (caterpillars, eggs)

Expressive Arts and Design

We will continue to explore different materials and use them to create 2D and 3D artworks.

We will develop our story telling skills and include these in our role play and games.

Literacy

We will continue to develop our drawing and writing skills.

We will continue to read a variety of books and start to make up stories to tell our friends.

We will learn about the alphabet. We will play games like I-spy.


We are half through the summer term already!
